General anesthesia and /or intravenous sedation /analgesia is limited to treatment by a contracted oral surgeon and in conjunction with an improved referral for the removal of one or more partial or full bony impactions (Procedures D7230, D7240, and D7241).

Any procedure that is not specifically listed under Schedule B will be paid by the patient at a thirty percent (30%) reduction of the Contract Dentists reasonable and customary charges.
